COMPENSATION CIRCULAR CM-421

To: All Coal Mine Compensation Insurance Carriers

RE: Proposal CM-1-2008
Revised Endorsements, Rating Values
Terrorism Risk Insurance Program Reauthorization Act of 2007

The Coal Mine Compensation Rating Bureau (CMCRB) has submitted and received approval from the PA Insurance Commissioner, four (4) endorsements required by the passage of the Terrorism Risk Insurance Program Reauthorization Act of 2007 (TRIPRA). These four endorsements are identical to the four endorsements approved for the PA Compensation Rating Bureau (PCRB) as announced in their circulars 1543, dated February 15, 2008, and 1544, dated February 22, 2008. It is intended and essential that the CMCRB maintain consistency with the PCRB and countrywide approvals.

Three of the approved endorsements are revisions to previously approved endorsements and are identified as follows:

WC 37 01 10 A-Terrorism Risk Insurance Program Reauthorization Act Endorsement
WC 00 04 21 B-Domestic Terrorism, Earthquakes and Catastrophic Industrial Accidents
Premium Endorsement
WC 00 04 22-Foreign Terrorism Premium Endorsement

The fourth endorsement is a PA specific endorsement that combines the coverages and rating values of the above three (3) revised endorsements into one new endorsement. This new endorsement is identified as:

WC 37 04 07-Terrorism, Earthquakes, and Catastrophic Industrial Accidents Premium
Endorsement

The statistical codes, rating values, and effective dates approved for the PCRB are also approved for the CMCRB.
