REVISED AND APPROVED

Proposal CM-3-2008 has been revised and the revised version has been approved by the PA Insurance Commissioner effective April 1, 2009. The revision consisted of lowering the proposed Traumatic loss cost for Anthracite Underground. All other Manual loss costs contained in the initial filing have been approved. The revised lowering of the Traumatic loss cost for Anthracite Underground did not change any of the overall percentage changes.

As approved, the overall percentage change in Manual loss costs is -14.4%. By coverage, the all classes combined changes are -17.1% for Traumatic, -3.0% for State OD, and -3.3% for Federal OD. The Employer Assessment factor shall be 0.0239 effective April 1, 2009.

Each policy with an Anniversary Rating Date on or after April 1, 2009 shall contain the newly approved loss costs and revised Employer Assessment factor. Such policies, if issued at other than the April 1, 2009 approval, shall be endorsed to include the newly approved values. No policy is permitted to be extended, or terminated and re-written, to take advantage of, or avoid the application of, the newly approved rating values.

All experience mods/merit factors currently issued for April 2009 have been issued on a tentative basis. The CMCRB will reissue the corrected employer cards with the mods/merit factors calculated on the basis of the approved filing. Employer cards effective May 2009 and after will be issued on the actual basis.

Reprinted Manual pages will be distributed in the near future.
